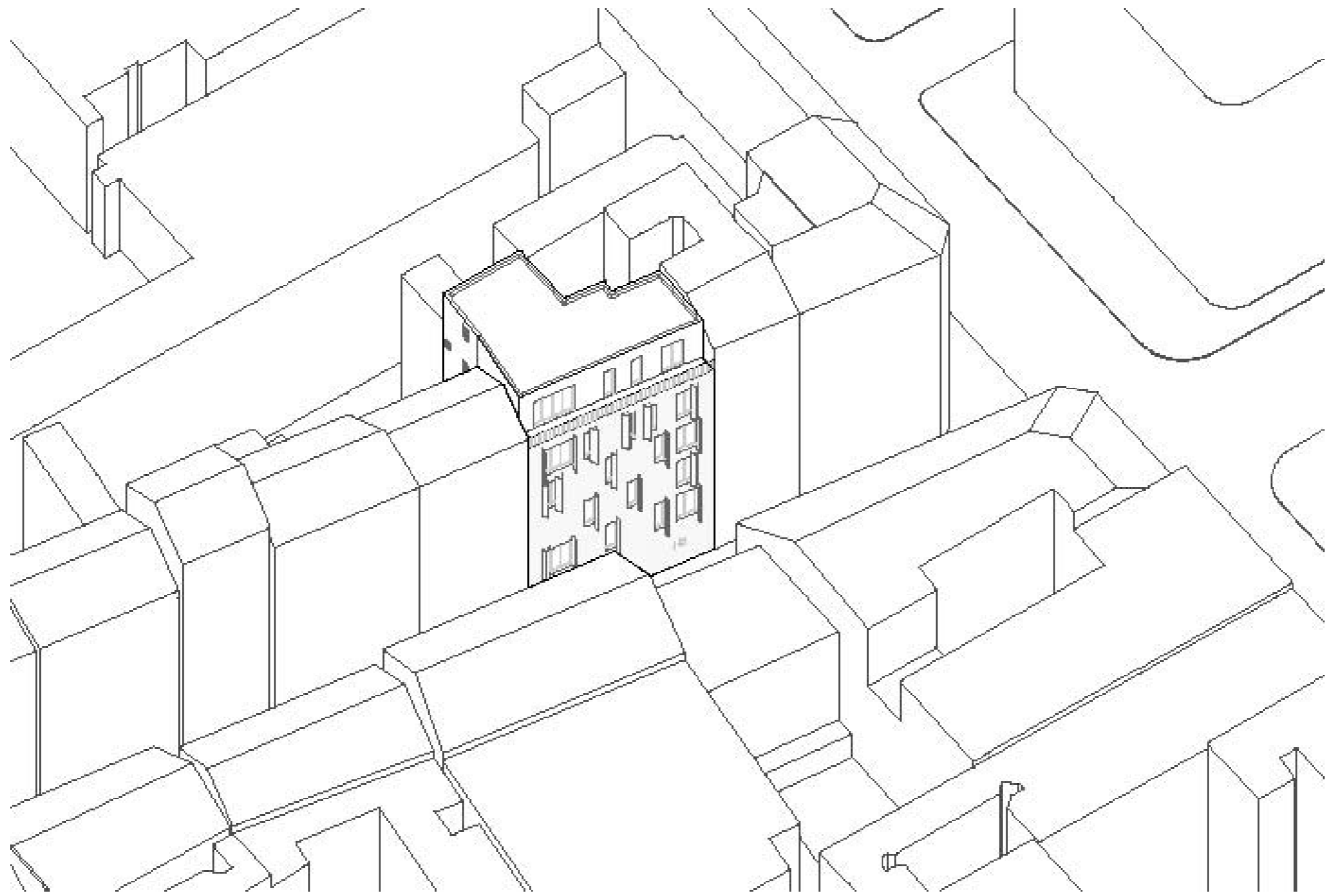

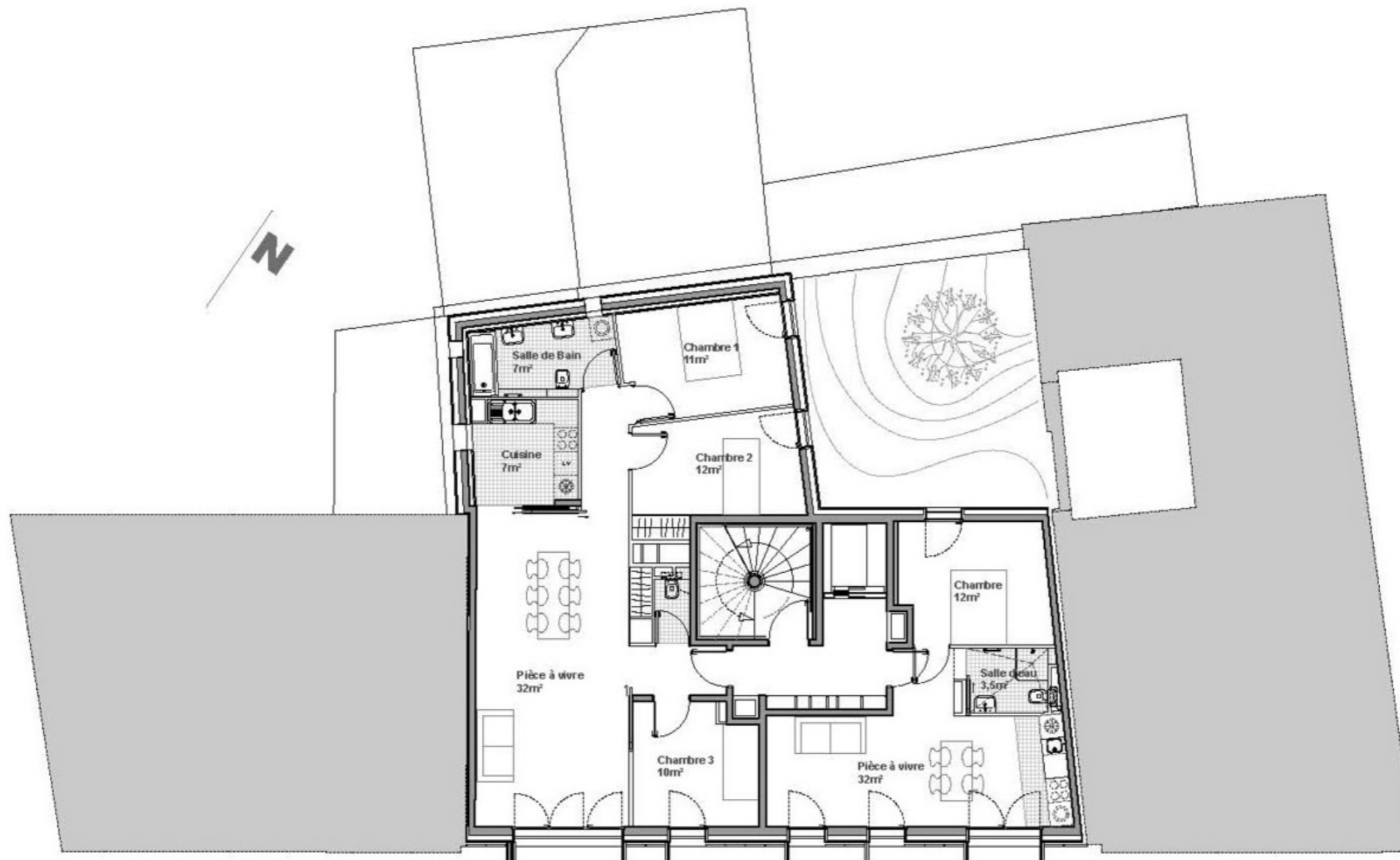


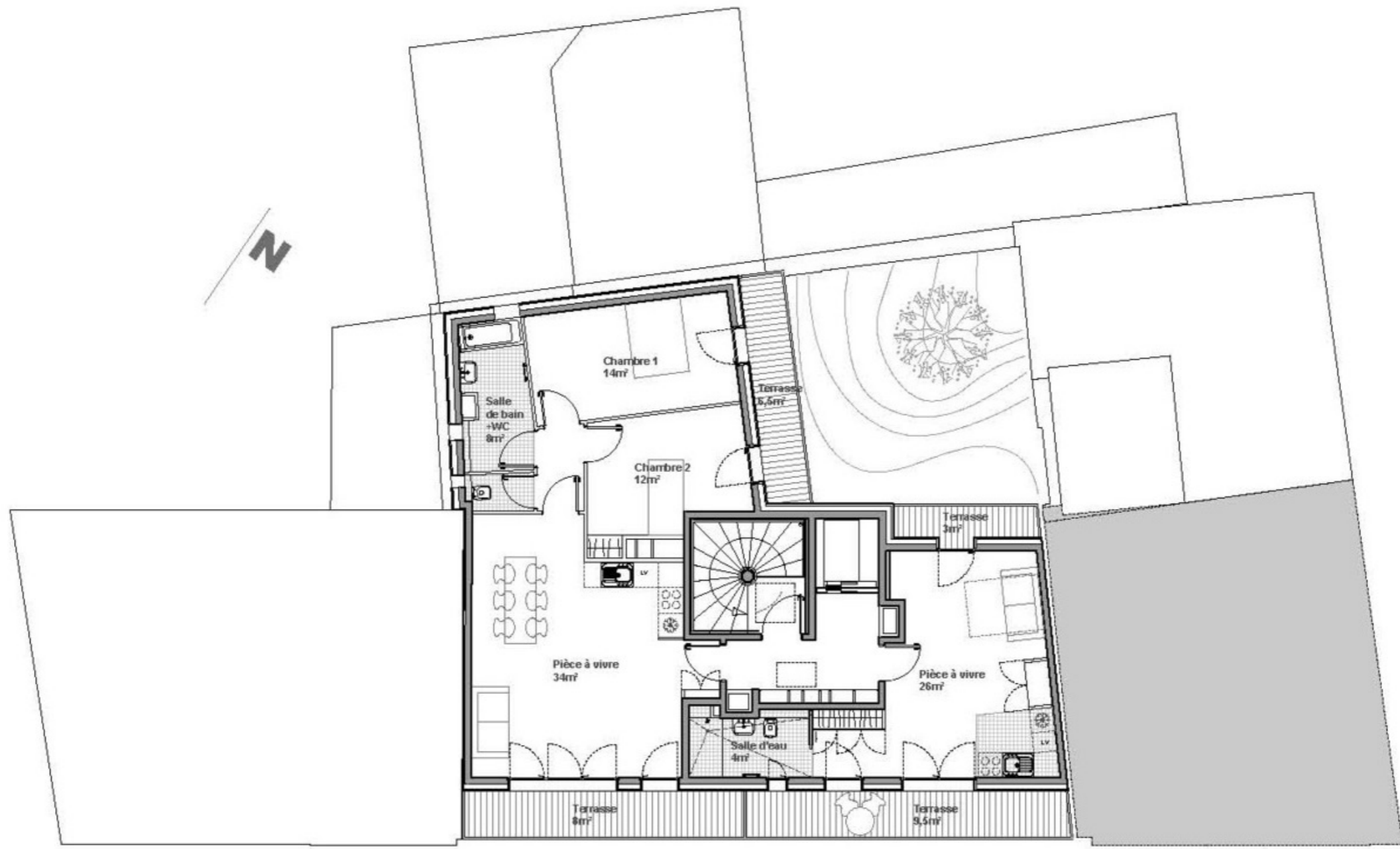














SOCIAL HOUSING IN POLAND

- 6.1% of flats in Poland are social apartments managed by the local governments
- In 2016: 868.0 thousand flats were social
- 10 m² minimal size of a flat– the lowest standard
- 5 m² minimal size of a room in a multi-room flat

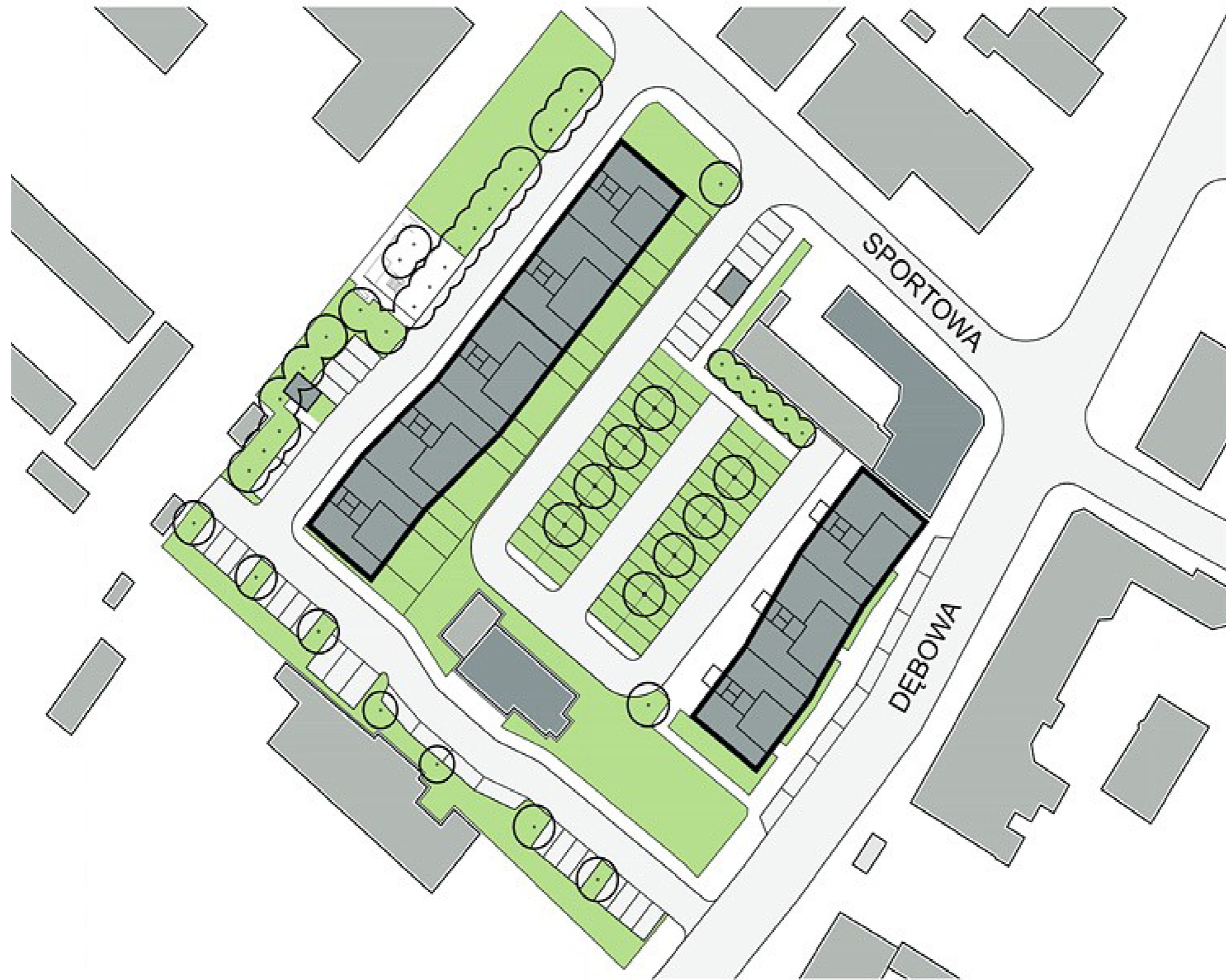

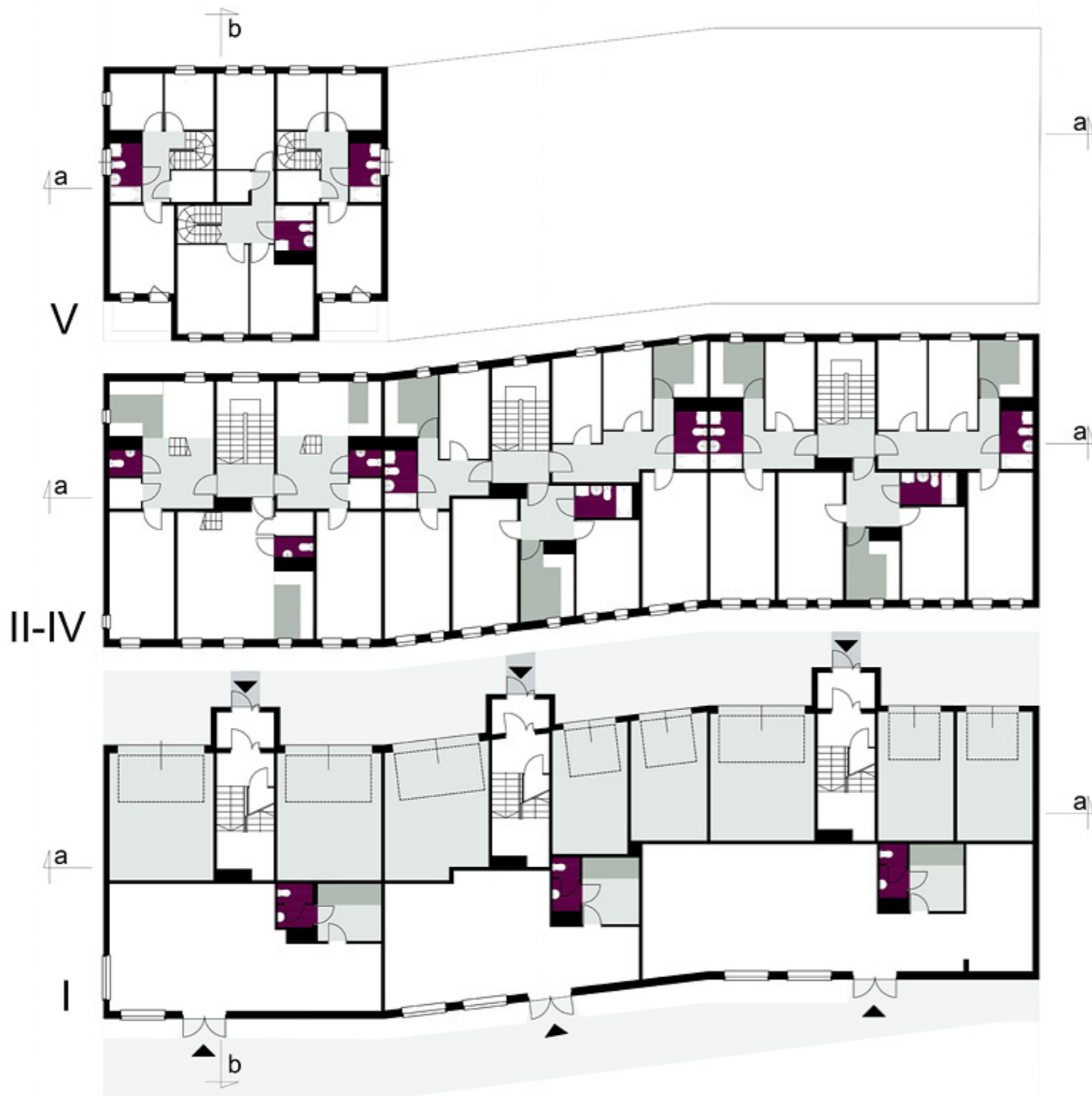

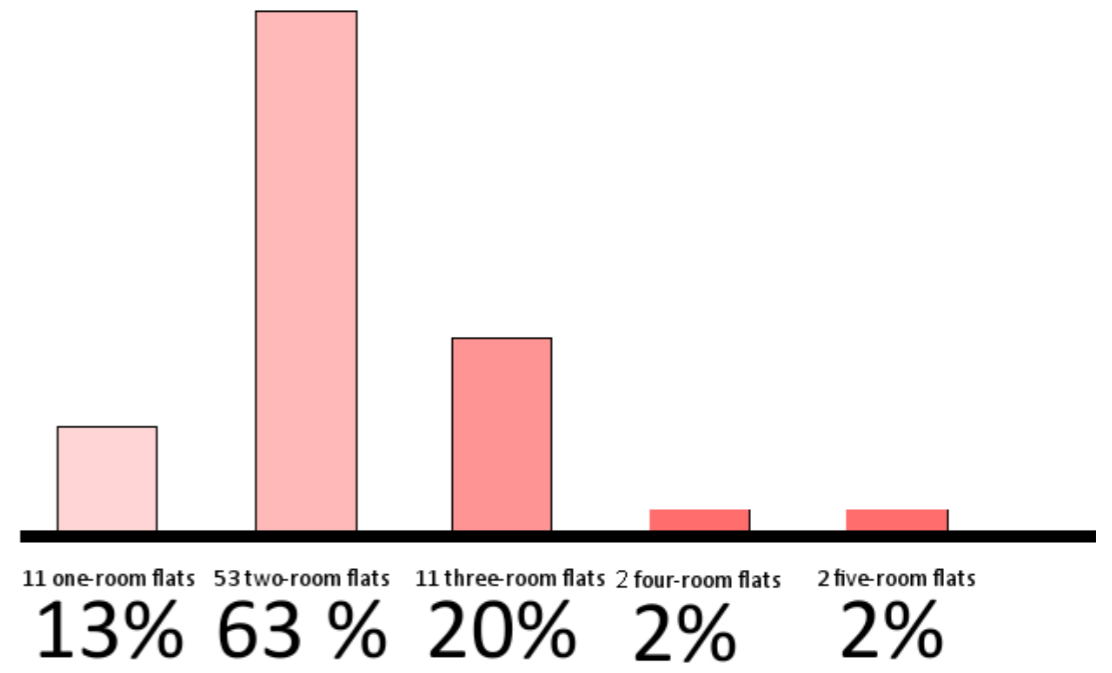
- 85 flats in 2 buildings

- 3 services rooms in the ground–floor

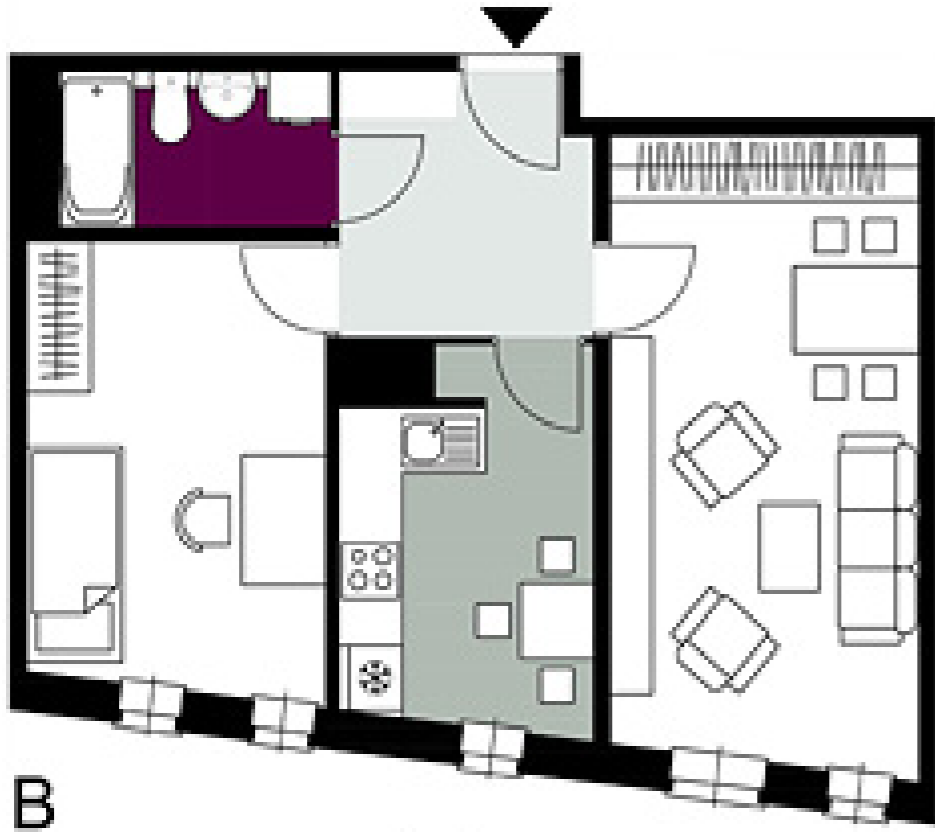




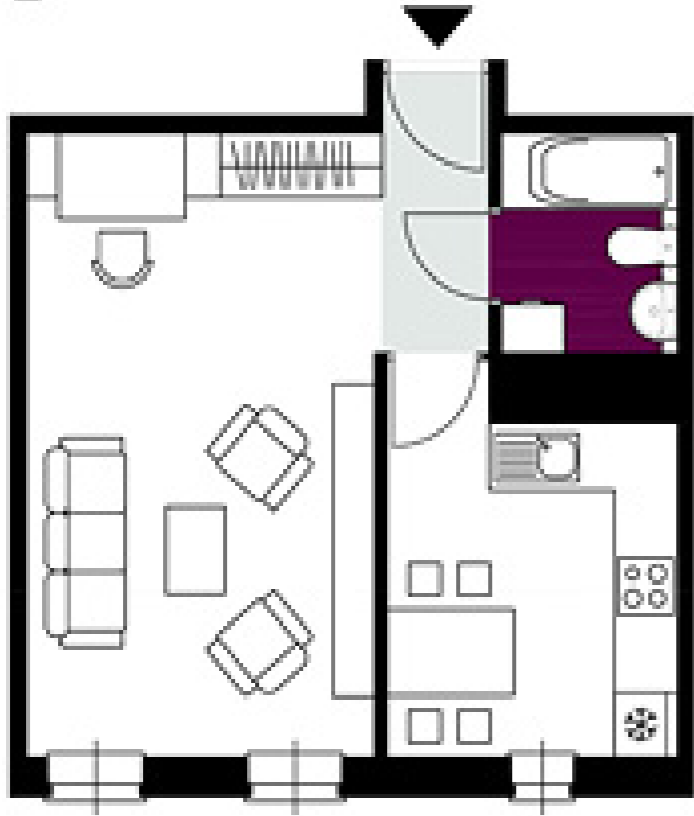


Number and percentage of flats in social housing Dębowa

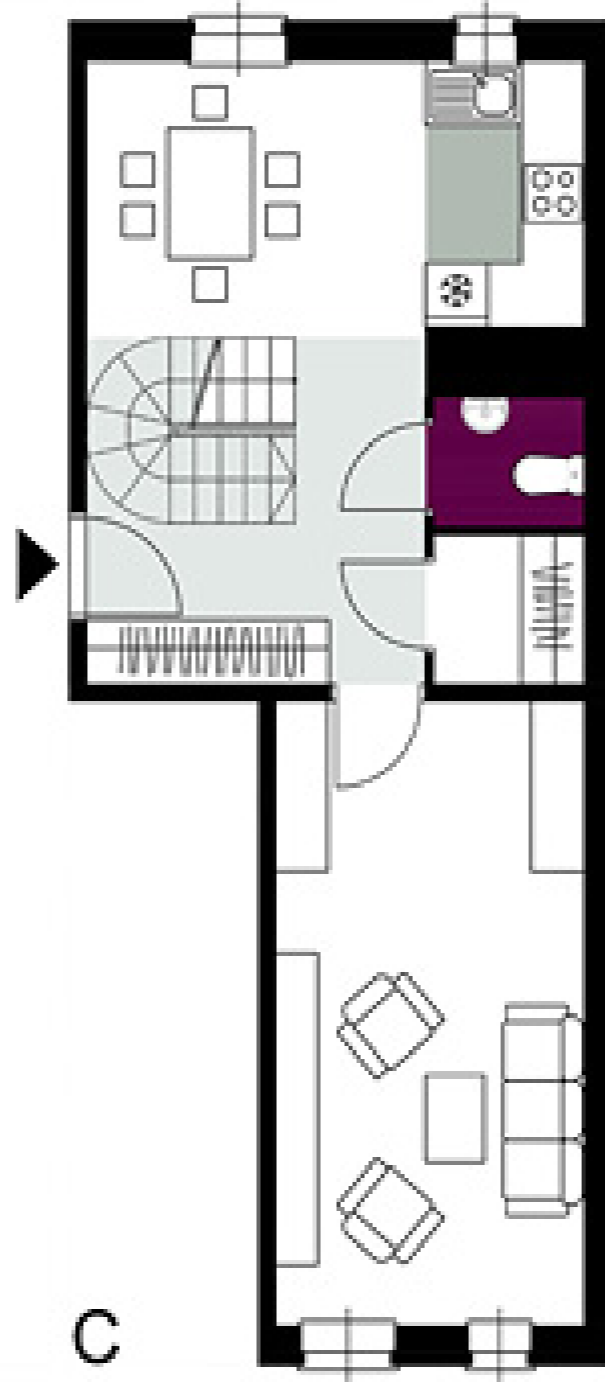




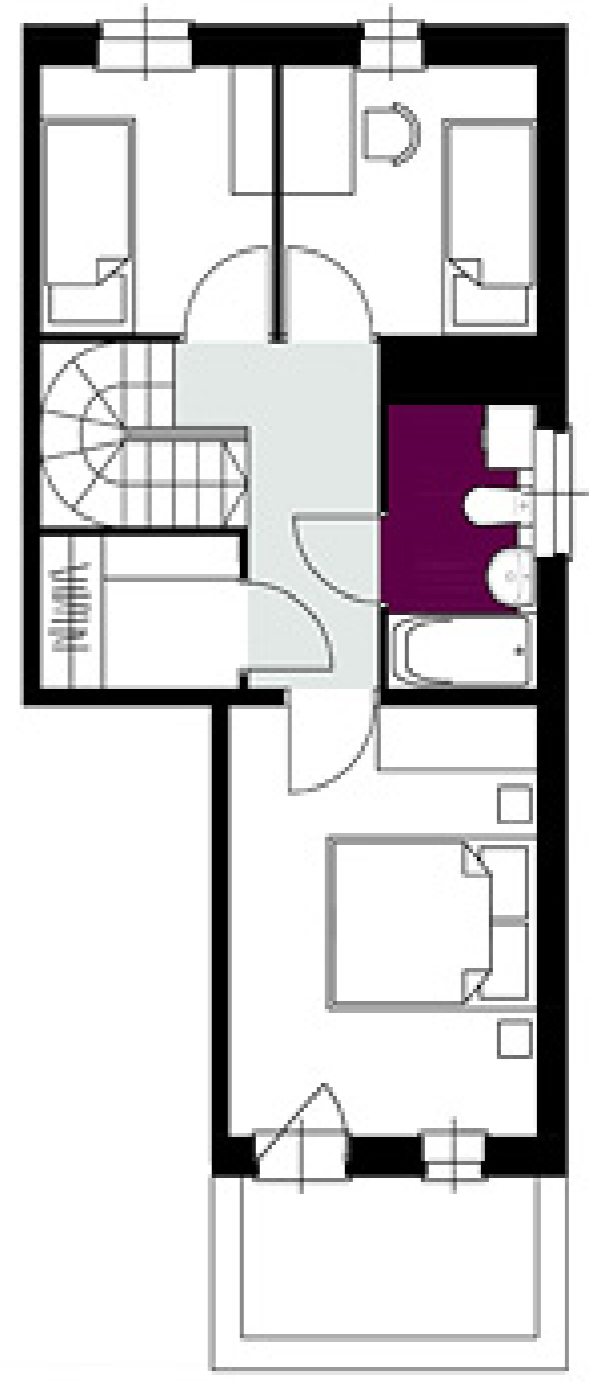
